

Can the Mid-Columbia Symphony borrow your lawn?

We are exploring ways to increase the visibility of the Mid-Columbia Symphony in our community. One way is lawn signs, similar to campaign signs. These signs are designed to announce our next concert. If your home is located in the Tri-Cities area and you have a street-side lawn visible to adjacent traffic, you may be able to help us advertise the Symphony! All you have to do is to authorize us to put our sign in your lawn. That's it! There is no cost to you.

This is how it works:

- 1) Contact the Mid-Columbia Symphony office by email (preferred) at this address:

Provide your full name, home address and your contact information including email and the best phone number we can use to contact you. We will only contact you if there is some sort of issue placing the sign.

- 2) Within about 3 weeks before the Mid-Columbia Symphony Holiday Concert (scheduled for Dec. 22, 2024) one of our volunteers will drop by your house and place a tastefully designed lawn sign in your yard. All we ask is that you make sure the lawn sign is always visible in the event it gets knocked or blown down.
- 3) About 1 week after the concert, one of our volunteers will stop by your house and pick up the sign.

That's all there is to it! This costs you nothing. You do not have to be home when we deliver and pick up the sign. We do all the work; we just need your approval.
