The Mid-Columbia Symphony, under the direction of Dr. Nicholas L. Wallin, is excited to announce auditions for section violin 1 and 2. The Mid-Columbia Symphony is located in Richland, WA., part of the Tri-Cities region in southeastern Washington state.

Position Summary:

- To begin with the start of the MCS 2025 – '26 concert season, plus subsequent seasons. Specific MCS 2024 – '25 concert season engagements are subject to section requirements.
- Typical season includes 5 concerts a season, 4 services a set, estimated 20 services per season.
- Compensation is currently \$75/service. Mileage reimbursed up to \$100 and housing provided.
- Rehearsal schedule typically involves a condensed set of 3 rehearsals before final concert.

- Auditions will be held on February 1, 2025 at the Columbia Basin College in Pasco, Washington
- All rounds are screened.

- The \$50.00 deposit will be returned in full at audition or if you cancel your audition 3 or more days before the audition date.
- The successful candidate must hold valid U.S. work authorization documents.

- Mozart, Symphony No. 39, mvt. 1, Allegro, m 26-142
- Mendelssohn, Midsummer Night's Dream. Scherzo. m 17- 7 after D.
- Brahms, Symphony No. 2, 1st movement. Rehearsal A through F.
- Tchaikovsky: Nutcracker Overture, Last 49 measures- top line
